

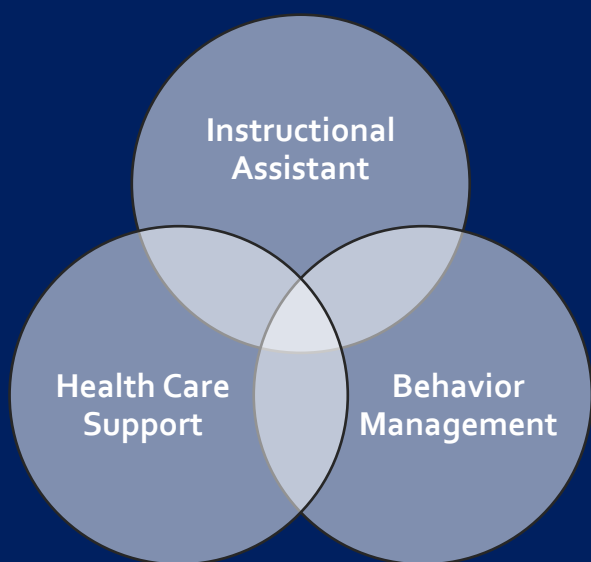

K-12 BEHAVIOR & HEALTH SUPPORT SPECIALIST TRAINING PROGRAM



A behavior and health support specialist paraprofessional is a blend of three roles as shown in the diagram above.

NOTE: There are different names for this position, with slightly different responsibilities attached.

This individual assists a certificated teacher in reinforcing instruction to individual or small groups of students who require additional support in order to be successful in school. The support specialist assists in providing learning activities and meeting the special needs of their assigned students in areas related to hygiene, feeding, positioning, toileting, motor skills, sensory and physical therapy functions. They will also monitor student behavior and health conditions, provide first aid, and may administer certain medications.

This 6-hour course will give participants practical skills training to help students with higher need behavior and health concerns. Through integrating modeling and scenario-based situations, learn applicable skills you can use immediately.
