The student will learn observation skills to analyze the development of children and how, as teachers, they can best help to meet their needs to become healthy individuals.

- Classes will be held on virtually on Zoom, with opportunities for regularly scheduled office hours (online) with your instructor and in-person observation (individually and in groups)
- Students will be able to earn 3 units of articulated credit from Southwestern College (CD170)
- This course is a pre-requisite for Southwestern's child development certificates, and meets GE requirements for other programs in education, healthcare, and social sciences
- Earn a Child Development Assistant Permit through the State of California after the completion of this course and our Child, Family and Community course (CD284) offered Fall 2022.
